Life Support Courses



BLS

Is a video-based, Instructor-led course that teaches both single-rescuer and team basic life support. The course trains participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED and the treatment of foreign body airway obstruction. It is designated to Healthcare Provider and People who are expected to respond to emergency in the workplace. It is a one day course.

ACLS

Is a video —based, Through the ACLS course, healthcare providers will enhance their skills in the treatment of the adult victim of a cardiac arrest or other cardiopulmonary emergencies; The course includes simulated clinical scenarios that encourage active, hands-on participation through learning stations where students practice essential skills individually, as part of a team, and as team leader. ACLS emphasizes the importance of basic life support to patient survival, the integration of effective basic life support with advanced cardiovascular life support interventions, and the importance of effective team interaction and communication during resuscitation it's designed for Healthcare Providers such as Physicians, Nurses, Paramedics and Allied workers. It is a 2 day course.

Life Support Courses



PALS

The PALS course gives healthcare professionals the knowledge and skills to better recognize and treat critically ill infants and children. The course uses a scenario-based, team approach to teach pediatric emergency management of pediatric patients approaching or already in respiratory or cardiac arrest. The course covers treatment beyond the first few emergency minutes and goes through stabilizing patients for transport phases in or out of the hospital. It is designed for Pediatrician, Emergency Physicians, Nurses, Paramedics and allied workers with direct contact in Pediatric emergency. It is a 2 days course.

NPR

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) course emphasize an evidence-based approach to care of the newborn at birth and facilitates eeffective team-based care for healthcare professionals who care for newborns at the time of delivery. NRP utilizes a blended learning approach, which includes online testing, online case-based simulations, and hands-on case-based simulation/debriefing that focus on critical leadership, communication, and team-work skills. It is co-sponsored by American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP). It is a one day Course.



Is a video based, Instructor-led courses teach participants critical skills needed to respond to and manage an emergency in the first few minutes until emergency medical services (EMS) takes over. The participants learn how to recognize, respond to and treat a variety of first aid emergencies, and perform CPR and use an AED in the event of a sudden cardiac arrest. This course is for anyone with limited or no medical training. It is a one day course.
